Lunch and Learn	<p>Genevieve spoke to Wendy Ahenakew and someone from the health center is available to provide us with a presentation on the topic of Anxiety on Wednesday, November 27th from 12:15-12:45. They will also look at doing something for us on the topic of bullying and can look at dates for that based on when we may want that, and it was discussed that maybe in January. December is not ideal because of the holidays and busy schedules.</p> <p>Discussed about using the Arts Ed room for the presentation. Bryce was going to look into this because there is usually choir there on Wednesdays, however he thought it could be managed for this particular reason.</p> <p>Action: Genevieve to confirm with Wendy Ahenakew about a presenter for a lunch and learn in November. Genevieve will get the information to Kristy.</p> <p>Action: Kristy will develop a poster and circulate for us to further distribute and advertise.</p> <p>Action: Bryce will email the poster, advertise through Facebook, newsletter, etc.</p>

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	Action: Rose to add this as a carry forward item to the next meeting
Fighting on the back playground	<p>Discussion regarding parents' concerns that their children are fearful of coming to school due to altercations on the back play ground. Discussion about preventative approaches including increasing supervision as a possibility.</p> <p>Discussion about other children witnessing being unsure of what to do, turning a blind eye to it.</p> <p>Concerns about racism being experienced on the playground.</p> <p>Joel indicated that they have added a 3rd supervisor in the back, this is an increase from the 2 that was always there,; however it was recognized that more could be used.</p> <p>Discussion about parents volunteering to do supervision. The school would be on board with idea of bringing parents in for supervision. Joel said that they could look at a system for parents to be part of supervision.</p> <p>Joel discussed the play ground peacekeeper program they started for the front playground that has been successful. 4 go out at a time, wearing bright vests. They help the supervisors as they watch for things or can be approached by students if there are issues and they can then assist in finding an adult supervisor. They get training through Joel in this role.</p>

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Discussion about asking Churchill students who may be interested in volunteer hours or just in supporting this. The physical space is huge in the back in terms of supervision and visibility of supervisors would be beneficial. Discussion about the Ice wolves helping at recess, which they have been and feedback has been positive about that as they play and interact a lot with the kids.

Joel acknowledged that the preventative approach is the most important and then shared with the group that there is also the reactive approach that they utilize when needed- Joel showed the flowchart for the processes that they follow when behavior management is needed. He indicated that he is interested in involving Elders in the process as well as more mental health support.

Genevieve shared about a recent CBC article that discussed a model of restorative justice that is being used in a school in Nova Scotia with good success, based on an indigenous model, using talking circles and open communication, with people sitting together focusing on mediating and repairing relationships and resolving conflict between the victim and the offender. It seemed like a promising approach.

Action: Ryan to add the behavior management plan to the Teams account.

Discussion about the numbers- we are a transient school. This related to the above discussion regarding bullying or misbehavior. Discussion about it can

Guided reading- fountas and Pinnell is providing training this week. We have been doing our own thing in past but now are adopting what other schools are doing.

Rose will be laying a wreath on behalf of SCC at the Remembrance Day assembly.
