Grade 1 start-up	Discussion ensued about families that have children starting grade one from kindergarten or from a different school. It was suggested that it may be helpful for families to receive information prior to starting school as to what the process is, school times, where to go/what to do. It was brought up that

	families appreciate being able to do a meet and greet or orientation prior to starting school and love the idea of home visits even in older grades to help build a relationship with the teacher, similar to what Pre-K does. Discussion about children who know what to expect feel safer and more comfortable in transitions, parents know what to expect and how to prepare and support their children, and relationships are stronger between the school and parents. Ryan informed everyone that Registration days were taken away because of instructional time push and that unfortunately this was one of the consequences of it.
